### Advance Hurricane Planning

Although the 2011 hurricane season does not begin until June, some officials are predicting "above average" activity for the season. A pair of Colorado State University research and atmospheric science experts recently predicted that there will be 16 named storms during the upcoming hurricane season, with nine of them becoming hurricanes. Five of those nine, say the two experts, will become major hurricanes. We, therefore, encourage credit unions to not underestimate the damage that an active hurricane season could cause or minimize the need to have an effective Emergency Preparedness and Business Resumption Plan in place.

### New Chairman Chosen for the Commission

Governor Perry has designated Thomas Butler as the new presiding officer of the Credit Union Commission. As Chairman, Mr. Butler serves at the pleasure of the Governor. He has served as a member of the Commission since 2005.

### New Appointments to the Commission

**Sherri Merket** of Midland, is an Administrative Assistant at Hillander Private School. She is a member of the Daughters of the Republic of Texas and Texas Humane Legislative Network. Mrs. Merket whose term will expire February, 2017, replaces Henry "Pete" Snow of Texarkana, whose term expired.

Mr. Tuma has served as board member for the Texas Credit Union League, Texas Institute of Certified Credit Union Executives, and chair of the Consumer Credit Counseling Services of the Gulf Coast. Mr. Tuma whose term will expire February, 2017, replaces Barbara Sheffield, whose term expired.

**Manuel “Manny” Cavazos IV** is a self-employed attorney, certified public accountant (CPA), and rancher. He is a member of the Texas Society of CPAs, American Bar Association, American Immigration Lawyers Association, California State Bar, and National Association of Consumer Bankruptcy Attorneys. He is being reappointed for a term to expire February 15, 2017.

## Registration of Mortgage Loan Originators

The time is at hand for credit unions to register their mortgage loan originators. Based upon preliminary numbers, it appears that many credit unions have not started the formal registration process. Credit unions that put off this mandatory registration may find that their residential mortgage origination program will come to a screeching halt if they cannot complete the federal registration by the July 29, 2011 deadline.


